

**THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(TORPEDO RANGE ROAD, ARROCHAR)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2013**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as “The Argyll and Bute Council (Torpedo Range Road, Arrochar) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013” and will be effective, when indicated by signs from 0001 hours on the 10th June 2013 and will remain in operation until such time as the works are complete. The Council are satisfied that the execution of the redevelopment works proposed will take longer than the maximum eighteen months. The Order is required for the duration of the works, anticipated to be approximately 34 months.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle (with the exception of vehicles in relation to the works or emergency services vehicles), on the entire length of the Torpedo Range Road (C55), Arrochar.
