Hi George,

Please find attached the final layout and technical drawings we have gotten from Stirling. They have produced these and approve the design for their roads and hoping we can approve these across the park to make production and erection easier.

The two we have agreed for use are the top middle sign layout at 75mm X height for 60/50 zones and the right hand sign at 62.5 X height for 30 – 40 zones.

We would be looking to have Transport Scotland agree to this too if possible as we can then progress to confirm the sign locations.

We will have approx.. 7 signs which are in the Trunk roads and may need to book a half day to visit sites and agree the positioning. We are looking to do this as a matter of urgency so we can get costs and move ahead with production and erection during December and January.

Can you arrange that at the meeting we would be looking to agree the two sign types for use

Can you investigate the use of your procurement framework (Bear Scotland) to produce and erect signage

Can you advise me of a date when you have enough time to visit and agree signage locations once we agree the sign layouts?
