I have looked into the matters raised and advise as follows:-

- I think you are aware that HIE/CML are planning a 'clear-up' of legacy redundant infrastructure (viz. snow-fencing, concrete bases, cables, Coire na Ciste café and chairlifts). This is quite a large exercise and, at present, we are preparing Works Information for tender documents, checking on consents required – our consultant, Colin Matthew, has been in touch with THC, SEPA and CNPA on such requirements. Once we have tendered the works we shall be clear on the costs and can then work on funding and programming.
