REQUEST UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

Following your request for information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, received by email on 19th February 2016 your specific requests and the relevant information held by the Park Authority are provided below.

Confirm whether Mr Shaw also passed on to the Park my letter of 14th December and if so when.

A letter sent from you to KPMG, dated 14th December 2015 was passed to the Park Authority on 18th December 2015.

The Audit states one of its objectives was to mitigate non-compliance with the "SPSO's model code of conduct" – I assume this means SPSO's model complaints handling process and the reference to a code of conduct is a mistake but would be grateful if you could confirm this or if not let me know what document was being referred to.

You are correct that the audit objective should have stated "SPSO's model complaints handling process".

How were complaints selected for the sample (i.e. was it random, chosen by KPMG on basis of the information in the complaints log or provided by the National Park)? If the complaints were chosen by the National Park on what basis did you choose them?

The Park Authority had no role in the complaints sampling selected by KPMG and holds no information on the basis of the sample of complaints that were examined by KPMG. Accordingly, I have to advise you under section 17(1)(b) of the Act, that the Park Authority does not hold the information requested on this subject.

Were complaints COMP 2015/001 and COMP 2015/009 included in the sample of 25 complaints considered by KPMG?

KPMG confirmed in December 2015 that complaint reference COMP 2015/001 was one of the files examined by them during the audit. The Park Authority holds no other information on the sample of complaints that were examined by KPMG.

Did anyone in the National Park alert KPMG at any stage during the complaints audit that you had had to breach your own complaints procedure due to having a lack of Directors in post to investigate complaints against yourself and Fiona Logan?
