REQUEST UNDER ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2004

I refer to your application to the Scottish Information Commissioner in relation to your request for information about externally funded research reports. I can confirm that I have had discussions with John Kelly the investigating officer in this case. As agreed with Mr Kelly, I have undertaken further searches to identify externally funded research costing over £3,000 commissioned by the Park Authority, and have identified a list of research on this basis, which is attached.

In addition, as discussed with Mr Kelly, I have also attached the organisational updates for 2012 and 2013, as well as a list which indicates the top level categories used for saving records according to the range of subject areas our business covers.

I appreciate that you have experienced some frustration in our handling of this request, and hope that this additional information will provide you with a better understanding of the work we undertake and the types of research that the Park Authority has commissioned. As the officer who manages requests, I endeavour to take on learning points in the handling of information requests and the Park Authority is committed to continue to proactively publish information that is in the public interest.
