Your request has been processed in accordance with Environmental Information Regulations (Scotland) 2004.

You requested:

SFRS incident report Dava Moor fire on 28/06/2025

In response:

I have attached a copy of the incident report as requested

Please note the information contained within IRS reports is recorded for analytical and statistical purposes.

The 'cause' of the incident is the officer's professional opinion and this is qualified by the passage issued by the Department of Communities and Local Government as follows –

"it is not necessary to be certain that the incident was due to the cause given, only that the cause was one that could be reasonably supposed given the evidence available".

Fire Investigation did not attend this incident, therefore, the IRS is the only report held. The SFRS hold no additional information.

In line with the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations (Scotland) 2004, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service has in place a procedure by which a review of the way in which we handle requests for information can be carried out. If you are dissatisfied by the way Scottish Fire and Rescue Service have dealt with your request or about any decision made by them in connection with your request, and wish a review to be carried out, please inform us within the next 40 working days by emailing SFRS.FOIRreviews@firescotland.gov.uk or by letter (Information Governance Team - SFRS Headquarters, Westburn Dr, Cambuslang, Glasgow G72 7NA). Requests must include the reason for your dissatisfaction.

Staff not involved in the original decision will handle any review.

Should you not be satisfied with the outcome of our review, you have the right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner within 6 months. The Commissioner will decide whether your request has been dealt with properly, in accordance with the Act.
